ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to play on November 15, you must be a resident of District 24 and you must have qualified at the club level for the appropriate flight during the NAP Qualifier games held over the summer of 2015.

You may play in one flight, depending on masterpoint eligibility (as of June 2015). You may play with any other player who has qualified for the event in the same flight.
