GNYBA Board Meeting Minutes – January 19, 2017

President's Report

David reported that there are currently 3, 324 members of the GNYBA, down 74 from 2016. The average age of our unit member is 69. As a retention effort, the group discussed ways to make new members feel a part of the group.

Action Item: Ellen Friedman will contact new GNYBA members and provide them with a list of clubs and who to call with questions.

Treasurer's Report

We still have over \$220,000 in our bank account. The December Edgar Kaplan Regional lost about \$5,000. There were 1,142 tables, down from 1.255 in 2015.

Tournament Report

<u>Eastern States Regional – May 2017</u> Stephannie Culbertson reported that the schedule has been finalized for the tournament and she is working with the ACBL for ads to appear in both the April and May <u>Bulletins</u>. She will contact BBO about placing an ad with them. The tournament will be held at the Hilton.

<u>Edgar Kaplan Winter Regional – December 2017</u>. Stephannie reported that the sanction request has been submitted. The tournament will be held at the Whydam – New Yorker.

<u>Victor Mitchell Pro-Am – February 3, 2017</u> Phil Lentz reported that there are currently 20 Ams registered, which is on par with previous years at this point in the registration process.

Action Item: Yoko Sobel will order convention card holders and pens to be given as gifts to the Ams.

<u>GNTs – February 2017</u> Phil Lenz reported that the dates are set and sanctioned for Saturday and Sunday February 11 and 12.

<u>STaCs</u> David Moss reported that the 3 week-long STaCs for 2017 are sanctioned and set. The dates are March 21-27, June 12-18 and October 6-12. In addition, the Newcomer Weekend (February 3-5) is sanctioned. Still undecided is when the GNYBA will hold its remaining three-day sectionals.
