Secretary's Report

B. Gellas presented the slate of candidates and proposed Board Officers for 2019 (the slate is attached) and introduced the new members in attendance.

Treasurer's Report

T. Ashmore reported that the tax returns have been filed and the GNYBA is up about \$5,000 for the year before the Edgar Kaplan Regional. .

Edgar Kaplan Winter Regional

- U. Ivatury reported that he sent about 500 postcards to all members who haven't been attending our regionals offering a 50% discount on card fees on the first event they play.
- B. Gellas reported the ideas agreed to by the Hospitality Committee and asked the Board to approve a budget (attached) of \$2,100 to provide door prizes, coffee vouchers, a newcomer registration gift, trophies for winners of the Countess Cup, prizes for top masterpoint winners in the 0-300, 300-750 and 750-2000 ranges, cash and other prizes to winners of featured events, plants and hand sanitizers,
