



2022 Grand National Teams - District 24 Final

Represent NYC and Long Island at the National Finals - Win GOLD Points

The Grand National Teams is played each year at the summer NABC. Teams qualify for the finals by district. District 24 consists of the GNYBA (New York City) and the NSBA (Long Island). To determine the team representing District 24 in each of the four flights, the District is holding our District GNT competition on the dates below. Location is TBD.

You must be a member of District 24 and your masterpoint eligibility is based on what was reported in your August 2021 Bridge Bulletin.

Players who play in the Championship or GNT-B Flight and do not advance beyond the opening weekend may play in the GNT-A or GNT-C flight, subject to all other eligibility requirements.
