District 24 Final

Flight A, B & C
Sunday, October 23, 2022
10:30 am & TBD (about 2:30pm)
Online on BBO (Bridgebase)

Based on the list that we received from the ACBL, you have qualified for the North American Pairs (NAP's) District 24 Final.

District 24—which includes New York City and Long Island—will hold a one day, two session tournament to determine who will represent the District at the Spring Nationals, to be held March 8-9, 2023 for Flight A, and March 18-19, 2023 for Flights B and C, in New Orleans, Louisiana. As all the District Finals will be held on October 23, you may play in only ONE of the flights in which you are eligible and qualified for. Please find your name in the district qualifying list (link below) to ensure that you qualified in the flight in which you want to play. (Note the list is sorted by unit and then name).

The cost to play is \$30/person, which includes both sessions. Make sure you have sufficient funds in your BBO account prior to signing up.

Depending on your masterpoint eligibility (as of June 2022 cycle):

Flight A: Open to all players

Flight B: Open to players with 0-2,500 masterpoints

Flight C: Open to Non-Life Masters with fewer than 500 masterpoints.

The top three finishers in Flight A, and top four finishers in Flights B and C, are eligible to represent District 24 at the Spring Nationals in New Orleans.

- 1st Place in each flight is expected to receive a travel subsidy of \$700 per player
- 2nd Place in each flight is expected to receive a travel subsidy of \$300 per player
- 3rd Place in each flight and 4th place in B & C may compete in the tournament but do not receive a stipend.

Players must be members of Units 155 or 242 (New York City or Long Island) as of June 1, 2022 and need to have qualified for the NAP at a local club or an NAP online game.

The District 24 finals will be held on Bridgebase and will begin at 10:30am. Please log in at least 15 minutes prior to game start. The link to the tournament will be found under the ACBL World Tournament section. As the sessions are on-line, playing records will be reviewed for evidence of illicit communications.
