



2024 Grand National Teams - District 24 Final

Represent NYC and Long Island at the Toronto National Finals - Win GOLD Points

The Grand National Teams is played each year at the summer NABC. Teams qualify for the finals by district. District 24 consists of the GNYBA (New York City) and the NSBA (Long Island). To determine the team representing District 24 in each of the four flights, the District is holding our District GNT competition on the dates below at 110 East 55th Street (6th floor).

ACBL uses your August 2023 Bridge Bulletin masterpoint total for the below eligibility cutoffs.

Players may play in multiple flights in the qualifying rounds but may only represent the district at the national level in one. All team members must be active ACBL members of District 24.

All rounds (2-session): 11:00 am, location 110 East 55th Street, 6th Floor, New York, NY 10022

Card fees will be \$240 per team per day (\$300 with no pre-registration)
